2024 SASJ FEI CSIY TRI-NATIONS TEAM COMPETITION

Dear Athlete

Thank you for submitting an expression of interest form for the 2024 SASJ FEI CSIY Tri-Nations Team Competition. The last time South Africa hosted this international event was in 2007. We are excited about the prospect of witnessing our talented riders showcase their skills and sportsmanship as they compete against nations from around the world.

Please note the following important details.

- The name and rule of the competition has changed from CSIOY to CSIY and Nations Cup to Tri-Nations. FEI notified SA Showjumping yesterday that this change is required due to the competition being held on borrowed horses.
- Barry Taylor has withdrawn from being the Convenor of Selectors. I will be taking up the position.
- The Chef d'Equipe for the South African team will be Brendan McNevin.
- Eligibility to compete for South Africa must be in order by the **21st of February 2024**
 1. As per FEI regulations Art 119
 2. Duly Registered to compete for South Africa
 3. The athlete must be a South African Citizen in the possession of a valid South African Passport
 4. Resident of South Africa and correctly registered with SASJ & SAEF

- The top eight athletes will be notified on **Monday 1st of April 2024**



- A **compulsory** training session will take place at Kumusha (Previously Kawena) on **Tuesday 2nd of April 2024 @ 09h00**. This session will involve the swapping of horses - It is imperative that you bring the horse that you will be providing for the SASJ CSIY Tri – Nations Competition.
- The top four athletes along with one reserve athlete will be notified on **Wednesday 4th of April 2024** (Please note that the reserve athlete will only receive colours if they compete)
- There is no remuneration of R12 000 for the selected athletes' horse being used for the pool of horses for this event - Unless the selected Athlete provides a second horse for the pool in which case the athlete will receive remuneration for each additional horse. Athletes not selected for the team who provide a horse for pool will receive the remuneration. All loaned horses selected for the event will be covered by Hollard Equipage Insurance *terms and conditions apply.

THE only time you may remove a horse from the pool and remain eligible for selection to the team, will be on production of a veterinary certificate by a SASJ appointed veterinarian.

The selectors reserve the right to remove a horse from the pool if they deem necessary, for whatsoever reason.
