SA Showjumping are excited to announce that South Africa is hosting an International Young Rider Team Event – FEI CSIY from 30<sup>th</sup> April - 4<sup>th</sup> May 2024 at Kyalami Equestrian Park, Kyalami, Johannesburg.

The upcoming Tri-Nations competition by South Africa Showjumping is set to feature a dedicated category for Young Riders, ranging from 16 to 21 years old. In a display of international collaboration, South Africa has extended invitations to top Young Riders from European countries, inviting them to compete alongside South Africa's talented youth.

The competition will be held on borrowed horses, with 12 horses required. (Incl. 4 reserve horses)

SA Showjumping is looking for horses to lease on the following basis:

- The horses must have competed at 1.20m or higher.
- The horses must be six years or older.
- The horses must be fit to compete.
- The horses will be subject to a vet check on the day of the competition.
- The horses will be insured by **Hollard Equipage** for the duration of the event. \*terms & conditions apply
- The horses will be stabled at Kyalami Equestrian Park, in controlled stabling for the event.
- SA Showjumping will pay the following per horse for the five days. (One day being a rest day)
  - R12 000 horse lease fee
  - R1000 trucking subsidy
  - 5 nights secure stabling

Final selection will be based on performance, rideability, size and soundness of the horse.

## **PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE**

### **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 - Training Session with Drawn Horses**

- Each Athlete will be given between 45 minutes minimum and 60 minutes maximum in total (including warm-up and cool down) to ride the drawn horse.
- A training period in the main arena with a course consisting of maximum eight obstacles including a combination. Each Athlete is permitted a maximum of 90 seconds per Horse.

### **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024 - Welcome A2 Competition**

- The Welcome Competition will run in accordance with Art. 238.2.1, against the clock.

### **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 – Competition in Two Phases**

- Competition will run in accordance with Art. 274.2, competition in two phases.

### **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2024 - Rest Day**

### **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2024 – Young Rider Tri - Nations Team Competition - FEI CSIY**

- The Competition takes place over two rounds, over the same course and is judged under Table A, both rounds against the clock.
