JUNIORS

AGE: 2022: from the age that the athlete turns 14 until the year the athlete turns 18 (as per FEI Rules)

HEIGHTS: As per rules and schedule. From 1.20m with max spread of 1.40m and 1.60m for triple bar.

The host Nation organising Committee may be able to assist with horses.

The horses will be leased on a first come first serve basis and limited per NF.

Riders from Guest NF's on leased or lent horses may compete at ONE Grade lower than the horse's recorded grade.

Riders on own/regular horses may only compete in their current recorded grade.

All visiting NF Athletes must produce proof of a horse's Grade from their member NF
