CONTENT

Determination of Qualifications

- Only registered horses/pony's and athletes may qualify
- Victor Ludorum is based on horse/pony and athlete combinations only
- Only recognised grades as determined from time to time by SASJ will qualify for KZNSJ Victor Ludorum awards
- Recreational grades will not qualify for KZNSJ Victor Ludorum awards
- All recognised grades and age categories will have one winner unless there is an equality of points

Determination of Winners

- The horse/pony and Athlete combination ranking points on the SASJ data base will be used
- The top qualifying horse/pony and athlete combination in KZN in each category and grade as at 31st December of each year will be declared the winner.

Awards

- Each winner will be presented with a commemorative memorabilia as determined by the KZNSJ committee from time to time.
- Where applicable trophies will also be presented to the winners.
