## SASJ Rule Directive 1/2022 – DUAL AGE LICENCE

Point (i) below MOTION ADOPTED WITH MODIFICATIONS AS SET OUT BELOW:

- (i) To introduce a dual age category at clause at paragraph 9.2 (A) of Annexure A to the SASJ Rules: MOTION ADOPTED WITH MODIFICATIONS AS SET OUT BELOW WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT.
- 9.2 (A) DUAL AGE LICENCE CATEGORY An athlete may apply for a Dual Age Licence compete as a Dual Age Category Rider from the beginning of the year in which he/she reaches the age of 16 till the end of the year in which they turn 18, if they have obtained 5 QR points at the Junior 1.35m level. The fee for this category shall be the same as the fee for adult category 1 riders. When competing in an Adult class/s at an Event, a rider with a Dual Age Licence Category subscription may not ride in any other age categories at that event.
- (ii) That those athletes who reached the age of 18 during the 2022 calendar year but prior to the incorporation of Rule 9.2A Dual Age Licence Category in Annexure A of the SASJ Rules and who elected to take up a Senior/Adult membership, shall be entitled but not obliged to relinquish their Senior/Adult membership and take up a Dual Age Licence Category membership for the remainder of the 2022 calendar year.
