



SAEF Group IX Passports

The SAEF Veterinary and Horse Welfare Portfolio has appointed passport Agents that will issue and validate passports

around the country. Please note that the Identification Page and Vaccination details in the passport must be done by any registered Vet. The list of Officially Appointed Agents is now on the SAEF Website. The Passport Protocol as well as the Operating procedure will soon be published and circulated and also made available on the SAEF Website as well.

The SAEF is currently in the process of implementing a standard passport for all horses in SA and look forward to having one passport across the board. Consultations and meetings are being held with Racing South Africa, SA Studbook and other stakeholders in the Equestrian world in a bid to achieve this. This process is however still ongoing. We will try as much as we can to communicate and keep you informed.

The current price per passport is R150.00 vat inclusive. Please kindly note that Passports are out of stock and will be available soon. We will notify you all as soon as stock arrives.




SAEF Medical Aid Cover

SAEF Provincial Federations


- The Provincial Federation consists of all the Associations that are present in a specific Province
- The council of the Provincial federations consists of the Provincial Chairs from the various Associations
- Issues that are in relation to a specific Association for example a dispute with regards to jumping in a province will still be handled by the specific Association
- The Province will handle all issues and disputes that are in relation to the Province as a whole

SAEF Club Registrations

With the slight change in the structure of the SAEF, Equestrian Clubs will no longer have to register directly to the Federation. In the year starting on the 1st of August 2014, Clubs will be required to register with the Discipline Associations.
