

# ANNEXURE B

## B GRADING AND QUALIFICATION POINTS

### 1 RESPONSIBILITY FOR GRADING

SASJ shall grade all Athletes registered with them in accordance with these rules.

### 2 QUALIFICATION ON NEW REGISTRATION

2.1 When an Athlete is first registered, he shall be graded at the lowest grade within his age group.

2.2 Athletes from foreign National Federations becoming registered in the Republic of South Africa shall be registered in the grade or equivalent grade, in which they were registered with their last Federation. All such registrations shall be without qualification points.

### 3 Definition of a QR Point

A QR point (Qualifying Round) shall be obtained by jumping a clear round in the first round of SASJ Graded competition;

Special competitions are not eligible for QR points,  
Dispensation is given to SANESA as per the agreement.

### 4 Qualification Points required as per the below table:

Pony Rider 90 to 1.00	5
Pony Rider 1.00 to 1.10	10
Children up to 90cm	Recreational no QR's needed
Children 90 - 1.00	5
Children 1.00 - 1.10	5
Children 1.10 - 1.20	10
Junior up to 90cm	Recreational no QR's needed
Junior 90cm to 1.00m	5
Junior 1.00 to 1.10	5
Junior 1.10 to 1.20	5
Junior 1.20 to 1.30/1.35	10
Adult Rider up to 90cm	Recreational no QR's needed
Adult Rider 90 to 1.00	5
Adult Rider 1.00 to 1.10	5
Adult Rider 1.10 to 1.20	5
Adult Rider 1.20 to 1.30/Open	10

### 5 Qualification Points when changing Age Categories

QR points are obtained from the first round of SASJ Graded competitions where the Athlete obtains a clear round.

QR points will be transferable to the next age category when an Athlete moves to the next age category.

## **6 Levels for Categories**

- 6.1 Pony Riders – up to and including 80cm (not requiring QR's)  
Pony Riders – 90 cm up to 1.20 (requiring QR's)
- 6.2 Children – up to and including 80cm (not requiring QR's)  
Children – 90cm up to 1.20 (requiring QR's)
- 6.3 Juniors – up to and including 80cm (not requiring QR's)  
Juniors – 90cm up to 1.30 (requiring QR's)
- 6.4 Seniors/Adults – up to and including 80cm (not requiring QR's)  
Seniors/Adults – 90cm – 1.30 (requiring QR's)

## **8 HANDICAPPING OF CLASSES**

**PR Classes may not be handicapped with any other age category.**

**CH Classes may be handicapped with junior classes.**

**Ch Classes may not be handicapped with Adult Classes.**

**A maximum of 2 heights may be handicapped.**

**Heights and age categories may be handicapped together**

**E.g. Ch1.00m / J1.00m / Ch1.10m / J1.10m**

1 AUGUST 2018 – Maximum number for handicapping classes = 1 class or both classes must have 8 or less and only 2 classes may be handicapped together.
