

Minimum Criteria to become a Learner Steward

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must write and pass an entry level test and complete the below requirements:-

- Must be a SASJ Member.
- Must be over 18 years.

Must work as a shadow Steward at 6 shows (time frame being a minimum of 1 year or maximum of 3 years).

Must observe the following while being a shadow steward:-

- Practice arena/Schooling area Control
- Horse Inspection/Passport Check
- Stables Check
- Pre & Post Competition Tack Checks

After 1 years practical training, 3 positive recommendations must be obtained before promotion can be considered.

EDUCATION

Apply to your Provincial Official Representative to write the Learner exam.

Must attend a SASJ Stewards Training Seminar.

Write Learner Exam - 80% passmark, 30 mins, open book.

Learner Exam may only be attempted twice per year

MAINTENANCE

Must attend the Annual SASJ Officials Seminar (at least) once every 3 years.

Must officiate at a minimum of 3 shows per year.

Officials that do not maintain their status, may be removed from the Officials lists and will have to reapply via their Provincial body.
