

## Minimum Criteria to become a National Judge

### REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must have worked as a Provincial Judge for at least 2 years, minimum 6 Provincial shows per year.

- Must be a SASJ Member in good standing.

Must have officiated at 3 CSN shows, as a member of the Ground Jury - to be arranged with your Provincial Official Representative.

Must have worked assisting an FEI L1 CD at a show - at least one full day.

Must have worked at 2 CSN shows (at least one full day (last day) at each show) as a Steward.

After 2 years of officiating as a Provincial judge, may be assessed by 3 different FEI L2 (or higher) Judges. 3 positive assessments recommending promotion must be obtained before promotion can be considered.

### EDUCATION

Apply to your Provincial Official Representative to write the National exam.

Must attend a SASJ Judges Training Seminar.

Write National Exam (Pass mark 80% - Open book - 1 hour).

**National Exam may only be attempted twice per year**

### MAINTENANCE

Must attend the Annual SASJ Officials Seminar (at least) once every 3 years.

Must officiate at a minimum of 6 shows each year.

*Officials that do not maintain their status, may be removed from the Officials lists and will have to reapply via their Provincial body.*
