

Minimum Criteria to become a National Steward

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must have been a Provincial Steward for at least 2 years and have completed the following requirements:-

- Must be a member of SASJ, in good standing.
- Must have officiated as a Steward at 6 x CSN events in past 2 years.
- Must have assisted at horse inspections, pre & post competition tack checks & MCP
- Must have assisted FEI Stewards at FEI Events & demonstrated good skills in the following:-
 - Communication
 - Organisation
 - Ability to work with other officials
 - Good knowledge of stewarding principles
- Must have demonstrated leadership skills & a good understanding of competitors requirements

After 2 years of officiating as a Provincial Steward, must be assessed by 3 different FEI L2 (or higher) Chief Stewards. 3 positive assessments recommending promotion must be received before promotion can be considered.

EDUCATION

Apply to your Provincial Official Representative to write the National exam.

Must attend a National Stewarding Training Seminar.

Write National Exam (Pass mark 80% - Open book - 1 hour).

National Exam may only be attempted twice per year

MAINTENANCE

Must attend the Annual SASJ Officials Seminar (at least) once every 3 years.

Must officiate at a minimum of 6 show days a year.

Officials that do not maintain their status, may be removed from the Officials lists and will have to reapply via their Provincial body.
