

Minimum Criteria to become a Provincial Steward

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must have worked as a Learner Steward for at least 1 year.

- Must be a member of SASJ, in good standing.
- Must have officiated as a Steward at 6 x CSN events in past 2 years.

After 1 year of officiating as a Learner Steward, must be assessed by 3 different FEI L1 (or higher) Chief Stewards. 3 positive assessments recommending promotion must be obtained before promotion can be considered.

- Must have performed the following to the satisfaction of the 3 x CS above:-
 - Practice arena/Schooling area Control
 - Horse Inspection/Passport Check
 - Stables Check
 - Pre & Post Competition Tack Checks

EDUCATION

Apply to your Provincial Official Representative to write the Provincial exam.

Must attend a Provincial Stewards Training Seminar

Write Provincial Exam - 80% passmark, 1 hour, open book.

Provincial Exam may only be attempted twice per year

MAINTENANCE

Must attend the Annual SASJ Officials Seminar (at least) once every 3 years.

Must officiate at a minimum of 6 show days a year.

Officials that do not maintain their status, may be removed from the Officials lists and will have to reapply via their Provincial body.
