SASJ REMINDER COVID 19 PROTOCOL

In terms of Government Gazette 43954, Government Notice 1278 “Amendment of Directions issued in terms of Regulation 4(1)(a) of the Regulations made under Section 27(2) of the Disaster Management Act (57/2002): Act: Measures to address, prevent and combat the Spread of Covid-19”:

1. A 10 -day period of quarantine and isolation applies to persons who are inside the Republic and have to be quarantined (either because they are suspected of having contracted COVID -19 or of having been in contact with a person who is a carrier of COVID -19) or isolated (because they are confirmed as clinical or laboratory cases having contracted COVID-19);
2. Contact tracing must be conducted for close contacts (any individual within two metres of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) of laboratory- confirmed or probable COVID -19 patients.
3. Testing is recommended for all symptomatic close contacts of confirmed or probable COVID-19 patients.
- 4.

In light of these regulations:

- a. All individuals who were in close contact with the individual who tested positive must take a COVID test.
- b. All these individuals must identify those persons with whom they have had close contact since being in contact with the person who tested positive and each of those persons must be contacted and must take a COVID test.
- c. All of the individuals identified above (i.e., persons who had close contact with the person who tested positive and anyone with whom these individuals have in turn had close contact) will not be allowed to enter the showground until they have had a COVID test and have tested negative.
