Directive on Water Jumps at SASJ events

At a recent executive meeting, SASJ resolved to encourage greater use of water jumps in classes at SASJ Events.

Whilst the final decision remains at the discretion of the appointed course designer, SASJ strongly supports their inclusion in appropriate contexts. Course Designers may introduce water jumps in various ways, including:

- At the end of the course allowing competitors to attempt it whilst not affecting their score and time.
- As an optional element within the course plan.
- Through venue-hosted open days, provided such activities do not contravene any rules governing National events.
- As part of the course
