



The 2024 Toyota Triple Crown Rules

- 1. The Triple Crown is a trifecta consisting of the following shows that are hosted by KPC and sponsored by Toyota SA in 2024.
 - a) Toyota SA Adult Outdoor Grand Prix 1 April 2024
 - b) Toyota SA Adult Championships 1 September 2024
 - c) Toyota SA Adult Derby 6 October 2024

2. Qualification & Eligibility of Horse & Rider

Restricted to all horse and rider combinations that qualify and ride in the three Toyota Triple Crown competitions in A1.50m championship class.

3. Order of Starting

As per 1.50m Championship class competition qualifying rules.

Qualification for SA Titles as per SASJ Regulations.

4. Rules

- Each horse & rider combination is a unique combination and will earn points as such.
- Horse and rider combination must enter all 3 shows to be eligible to win the triple crown.
- Each combination will be assigned points based on their results of the Adult 1.50m championship class.
- The winner of the entire series will be the combination with the highest total number of points after all three shows.
- In the unlikely event of equality in points the winner will be the combination with the lowest number of penalties across the three shows, excluding the jump-off rounds.
- Should there still be equality of points then the combination with the quickest time in the first round of the Outdoor Grand Prix will win the title.
- The winner of the Triple Crown will be announced at SA Derby where they will be presented with the Toyota Triple Crown car.

5. Scale of points

Placing in the championship Class	Points Awarded
1	20
2	17
3	14
4	12
5	10
6	8
7	6
8	4
9	2
10	1

Points are awarded on the SA Title Classes to horse/rider combination. Competitors that tie are awarded full points for that place e.g. tied 2nd means that the ties both get 17 points and there will be no points allocated for 3rd place.

6. Toyota Triple Crown Series

Overall Winner of the Toyota Triple Crown Series will be awarded a Limited Edition Toyota Crown vehicle.

7. Toyota Bonus Award per event

Should the winners of the Outdoor Grand Prix and the SA champs win on clear (zero penalties) over all rounds in the championship class they will receive bonus awards as follows:

- a) Toyota SA Outdoor Grand Prix bonus award to the value of R65 000 over and above the first-place prize of R35 000
- b) Toyota SA Championship bonus award to the value of R60 000 over and above the first-place prize of R40 000.
- c) Toyota SA Derby guaranteed bonus award to the value of R50 000 to the winner over and above the R100 000 first place prize.

Should the winner not have won on a clear (zero penalties) over all rounds in the championship class then the bonus prize money will be donated to a charity as chosen by Toyota SA.

8. Eventualities

 Horse and rider combinations must qualify and compete (go through the start) in the 1.50m championship classes which make up the Toyota triple crown series to be eligible for the Toyota Cown vehicle prize.

- If a horse and rider are leading but for whatever reason have dropped out of one of the legs then they are out of contention, regardless of the points (even if they are the eventual winners on points). The combination did not compete all three legs.
- In the case of a dispute not covered in the rules or is ambiguous then Toyota SA has the final decision.
