## **Selection Process YOG 2018**

At this stage we await final confirmation from FEI/SASCOC that our Federation/Sporting Code has qualified to represent South Africa at the YOG.

Athletes who have qualified at the 2017 RSA FEI Jumping Challenges (According to the YOG Qualification document published by FEI) need to compete at Open level at the following selection shows;

2018 Presidents Cup (12 Athletes will be published on a short list after this event)

2018 Easter Show (8 Athletes will be published on a short list after this event)

2018 Midrand World Cup Show – (Separate Junior Show)

This event will start with 8 riders and finish with the Top 4 Athletes.

(These top 4 Athletes will be selected for the Final SASJ Special event)

The Selected 4 Athletes on the Final list are to compete at a SASJ Nominated event in June/July 2018 where the 4 athletes will ride strange horses., (if a rider refuses the invite then the next rider on the list will be invited to compete).

The final athlete will then be chosen after this event.

Timelines are dependent on SASCOC criteria and could be subject to change.
