CLOSING DATE AND IF NOT PAID THEY WILL BE DELETED OFF THE SYSTEM.

Proposed times will be on all relevant Discipline websites from 6th March 2019.

Prize money: 40% of entry fees.

Entry fees: SJ – Jnr R200 per horse per class

Adults – Recreational R180 per class, 090m – 1.25m R200, Open R220 per class. Includes portion of R1300/day Paramedics levy, and all applicable discipline levies. Dressage – R180 per horse per class. NOT GRADED – DEVELOPMENT ONLY. Equitation – R180 per horse per class. Graded – Discipline levies applicable. ALL relevant Discipline Levies will apply and are included in entry fees.

Team Entry: R800 per team (Includes R11.40 per round SASJ Recreational Show Levy)

Ground Levy: R210 per horse entered in the show - only paid once per horse / pony

Temp Membership: R330 for non-members of the Durban Shongweni Club for the duration of the show.

Stabling: R225 per stable per day,

Jury of Appeal: Judge of the relevant class, plus 2 other technically qualified people.

Dress: School Blazers and school ties may be worn in all classes.

Notes: This Interschool competition is in no way affiliated to SANESA Schools.

- 0.70m 0.90m run at a speed of 300 meters/minute. 1.00m run at a speed of 325 meters/minute and 1.10m 1.30m run at 350 meters/minute.
- PR 0.70 0.80m run at 300 meters/minute. PR 0.90 1.10m run at 350 meters/minute
- The organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine, limit or divide classes if necessary and if number of entries does not warrant the running of the class. In addition the organizers reserve the right to change arenas should conditions or entries warrant the change.
- Entries will be limited to the prescribed practical maximum of 180 rounds per day on a first received basis. Dressage & Equitation entries will be restricted due to time available. Preference will be given to team riders.
- No Rider may compete on more than 3 horses in any one class.
- Please note that riders must state clearly which classes and grade they wish to enter. Changing from Grade/Classification to a different Grade/Classification at the show is permissible at the discretion of the show holder. N.B: SUBSTITUTIONS OF HORSE OR RIDER HAVE TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO START OF THE CLASS.
- Should the Substitution be Horse AND rider Substitution Form has to be signed by <u>both</u> old and new competitor and Substitution Form received by show holder 24 hours prior to the start of the show.
- All horses/ponies and riders must be registered with SAEF. Dressage will be run as a Recreational Show Rider registration is free. If you are not a registered member of Equitation SA you may pay the required Temporary Membership Fee consult website or entry form.
- Should there be sufficient entries handicap classes may be separated.
- Entries out of order by closing date will be forfeit.

INDIVIDUALS RIDING FOR SCHOOL TEAMS; Competitors participating in School Teams must be entered in the Individual event for the same Discipline and enter on the Team Entry form as well. Individual entries must be paid even if entered in a School Team.

PONY RIDERS: Pony riders wishing to compete on their ponies for their High School may do so as long as the Rider is a registered learner in their High School i.e. Grade 8 and above.

Dressage: ALL DRESSAGE WILL BE RUN AS TRAINING CLASSES. Ie, NO GRADING POINTS APPLICABLE.

Pony Riders will be required to ride the relevant Junior Test in a 60 x 20 arena

Equitation: Pony Riders will be required to ride the relevant Junior Test and height – with no adjustments made for striding – and their entry will be considered an HC entry – i.e. not eligible for individual prizes or grading points, but their score will be put forward to their nominated Team's score.

Show Jumping: Pony Rider graded classes are on offer and will be considered as the required Individual Entry to qualify for Team Selection. However, the Team Event, will be run as per normal for horses and there will be no allowance made for pony striding.

No Adult to ride any Junior/Child/Pony Rider horse/pony entered in the show from one hour prior to the first class of the show until the end of the team jumping under penalty of elimination.

GENERAL RULES FOR SCHOOL TEAMS:

- 1. ALL Riders & Horses nominated to ride in a School Team <u>MUST</u> <u>compete in the Individual classes</u> of their Registered Grade in the discipline they are selected to ride the Team Event in. All Competitors participating in School Teams must enter on both the Individual Entry form and the Team Entry Form and each to be paid for separately.
- 2. ALL Riders representing their school in a school team must be pupils of the High School Section of their School. This is not a show for Junior School Pupils. i.e. Pupils to be registered in Grade 8 or above.
- 3. All teams are to be nominated and entered on the special Team Entry Form, signed and stamped by the Principal or person designated by the School. Competitors participating in School Teams must enter on both the Team and Individual Entry forms.
- 4. A Team shall consist of 4 riders/4 horses provided they are all pupils of the same High School. Or a minimum of 3 riders/3 horses from the same school. The best 3 scores will count towards the Team Results in all disciplines
- 5. Only one horse per rider per team (school) per discipline will be allowed
- 6. Schools may combine, provided they do <u>not have 3 riders in any one School</u>. A combined School Team may consist of 3 or 4 riders.
 - a. All Dressage Teams must have their final team confirmation 1 HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE COMPETITION ON Friday 15 March 2019. Any changes made thereafter will be null and void
 - b. All Equitation Teams must have their final team confirmation by 07h45 on Saturday 16th March 2019.
 - c. Showjumping Teams participating must be confirmed by the end of the last showjumping class on Saturday 16 March 2019, by the Chef d'Equipe at a meeting with the Show Organisers under the Judges Box failing which the original School Entry will be accepted to be correct.
 - d. A School Team entering two or more teams please note: If a horse in a Team is unable to compete, the 4th rider/horse from either of the Teams may change Teams. The change of rider must be nominated
- 7. I hour prior to the start of the event.
- 8. The order of riding will be determined by a draw done by the organizers.
- 9. Team Turn Out Competition & Parade is limited to ONE team of 4 horses and riders per school. It does not necessarily have to be the A Jumping Team any 4 horses and riders can be nominated for the Team Parade as long as they competed in a team event. Please note that the Organisers require a list of these horses and riders for the announcer.
- 10. In support of fair play we encourage schools NOT to purchase new tack for this event. The judges will be looking for tack that is well cared for and correctly fitted!

Open to Adults & Juniors & Pony Riders. Registration with DSA not compulsory.

Riding up or down a grade is NOT permitted with the exception of Medium Horses that may ride E-M with a 5% penalty.

jump off against the clock.

NOTE: 2 parallel tracks will be built for the Team Show Jumping. One track at max. 0.90m and

the other at \pm 1.10m – at the discretion of the course builder.

All horses graded 1.10m and up will be required to jump the higher track.
