## Rules and Regulations - Showjumping and Stadium Eventing

- 1 This show will be run under the rules of SAEF, SASJ and all relevant rules and regulations apply.
- 2 The SAEF and SASJ levies have been included in the entry fee.
- 3 The Organising Committee, the Show Holding Body, SAEF, SASJ and Pondarosa Ranch cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses or property whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk.
- 4 Sponsors, owners, riders, horses and ponies must be registered with SAEF, SASJ and the Primary Club of choice in the Riders/Owners Geo-Political area, for the 2019 subscription year as at the closing date of entry. Entries out of order at closing date will be forfeited.
- 5 In the interest and welfare of the horse, horses and ponies may only compete in 2 classes per day
- 6 Late entries will be accepted with a surcharge of R100.00 in addition to the class entry fee. Entries without proof of payment will not be accepted.
- 7 Any requests for a specific riding order MUST be emailed to the SHB. It is the responsibility of the competitor to make sure their entries have been received.
- 8 The Show Holding Body reserves the right to alter or vary the programme in light of prevailing conditions at their discretion. Junior and Adult classes may be combined if there are less than 8 entries per class. Placings will be awarded separately
- 9 Should the show be cancelled, not postponed, then 70% of entry fees will be refunded
- 10 As per FEI Article 256. 1.4, It is compulsory for all persons to wear a properly fastened protective headgear with a three point retention harness at all times when mounted. Competitors shall wear the correct dress for competitions.
- 11 Stabling will be allocated by the Pondarosa Ranch Staff and alteration of stabling allocation may only be made with prior consent of the Show Administrator. Special requests should be indicated on stable booking form. Competitors may erect own day paddocks in designated area at own risk. Horses and/or ponies may not overnight in day paddocks.
- 12 Parking in designated areas only. It is encouraged to not bring dogs to the show. If they are brought, they must be on leads (there will be a FINE of R50 for unleashed dogs).
- 13 All stallions must have a yellow disc on both sides of the bridle or have a yellow ribbon in the tail.
- 14 **Equine Flu Vacs must be administered within 6 months + 21 days of the date of the event. No horse may compete in the 7 days after the vaccination. AHS VACCINATIONS MUST BE IN ORDER**

## Rules and Regulations - Showing

- 1 There will be an R80 Levy for adult graded competitors and a R60 levy for child/junior graded competitors.
- 2 No SASA Membership is required for Newcomers or In-Hand Classes.
- 3 Rosettes/Prizes will be allocated at the discretion of the organizers.

Prize Money a minimum of 40% of entry fees (less levies) for all graded shows

- 4 **Non SASA members will pay a temporary SASA membership fee of R80.00  
Temporary SASA members will not earn Grading or Victor Ludorum Points.**
- 5 COACHES that are members of SASA will earn 2019 Coaches Victor Ludorum Points for competitors that are entered in Graded classes.
- 6 SASA EDT Scheme will pay all entry fees for all classes for registered members of the SASA EDT Scheme. Prize winning registered EDTS competitors will receive SASA Victor Ludorum Points.
- 7 SASA Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website:  
www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za.
- 8 No cross entries between Open and Novice classes (i.e. you may not do open show hack and novice show riding. You may only cross enter between showing and working classes i.e. open showing and novice working classes.
- 9 Competitors may however enter different horses/ponies in each category.
- 10 Some Junior and Adult classes may be combined, but separate prizes will be given.
- 11 **ALL CHAMPION HORSES/PONIES (NOVICE AND OPEN) ARE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE  
IN THE SUPREME SHOWING AND/OR WORKING HUNTER AND WORKING RIDING  
CHAMPIONSHIPS AT THE SHOW**
- 12 Horses and riders take part in these classes at their own risk. The organisers reserve the right to limit the number of entries accepted to manageable numbers on a first come first served basis. Any and all decisions made by the Show Director in terms of the collation, organization and management of the show will be deemed final and no further correspondence will be entered into. The organisers reserve the right to combine and/or cancel classes. Working Hunter and Working Riding horses/ponies are judged together.
- 13 **NB! COMPETITORS MUST HAVE AN UP TO DATE HEIGHT CERTIFICATE IN THEIR HORSES/PONIES  
PASSPORTS. PASSPORTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION ON REQUEST.**
- 14 **All persons participating at this event do so at their own risk and will have no claim against the  
Pondarosa Ranch Club, its owners, SASA, SAEF, including any officials, employees, members, affiliated  
bodies, show-holding bodies or sponsors, for any damage or loss of property or death or injury of  
persons suffered during or in connection with this event from any cause what so ever. No minor may  
participate in this event without the permission of his/her guardian, who indemnifies all mentioned above  
against any such claims by such minors.**
- 15 **HORSES WILL BE RIDDEN BY THE JUDGE IN THE OPEN GRADED JUNIOR AND ADULT CLASSES.**
