Entries:

Entries close on Wednesday 27th August 2014 and will only be accepted if they have been received by the Secretary by that date.

PRIZE MONEY:

A minimum of 60% of the total entry fee will be paid out to CN status classes and a minimum of 40% will be paid out to provincial classes. This excludes any sponsorship money offered independently from the allocated prize money.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Applicable Rules:

The Event will be conducted under the relevant discipline rules and regulations.

Membership:

All owners, riders & horses must be registered with their club and discipline and affiliated to SAEF or an FEI Group IX National Federation as at closing date of entries. All horses entered must have a SAEF Horse Passport or a Group 9 passport. Please do not hesitate to contact SASJ with your query regarding membership –

Dress:

See SAEF Rules for the various disciplines. No Provincial or sponsored shirts may be worn.

Treatment of Horses & Conduct of Riders:

As per the relevant discipline rules. Drug testing may be done at the discretion of the Discipline Executive

Equine Influenza and African Horse Sickness

All horses must have been vaccinated against Equine influenza according to SAEF regulations. Vaccinations are valid for six months and must be renewed prior to expiry; otherwise primary and secondary vaccinations will have to be re-administered. All horses travelling to the AHS surveillance area / Free zone must apply according to the SOP for entering into the Controlled area prior to the commencement of the return journey. A Permit must be issued by the State Veterinarian and be accompanied by a valid health certificate (in the passport) signed by a Private Veterinarian, not more than 48 hours prior to travelling. All ponies must have been vaccinated by a VETERINARIAN against African Horse Sickness using a registered polyvalent African Horse Sickness vaccine as prescribed by the manufacturer and in accordance with SAEF Veterinary rules.

All ponies must be in possession of and be accompanied by a SAEF or FEI Group IX passport, number to be included on the entry form. Details of all vaccinations must be entered in the passport. A random check of passports will be conducted to ensure that they comply. Competitors not complying with the above will be fined and may be refused entry onto the grounds. No entries will be accepted without the relevant AHS and flu vac details. No flu vaccination may be administered within 7 days of arriving at the show grounds.

Substitutions:

Application for substitutions must be made on the form provided at the secretary's office not later than 30 minutes before the commencement of the competition concerned or as per the discipline rules. The new rider must sign the substitution forms, indicating that he has the consent of the competitor originally entered.

Grooms Facilities:

No groom's accommodation is available. Competitors are advised to provide their groom with suitable accommodation (tents etc.) Ablution facilities, with hot water, will be provided. Meals will be available for the duration of the show from .The grooms will receive 3 meals per day including coffee and cool drinks the cost will be **R150** per day.

No tents are allowed to be erected in the stable block perimeter.

Cancellation and combination of classes:

In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the organizing committee, in conjunction with the discipline representatives, reserves the right to cancel or combine classes and restrict entries (other than those applicable to championships and their qualifying classes) to a practical number. Entry fees will be refunded for any entries not accepted.

Variation of programme:

The programme will be adhered to as far as possible. The organizing committee in conjunction with the discipline representative reserves the right to make alterations in the event of insufficient or excessive entries, unfavourable weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Competitor Obligations:

- Athletes are obliged to ride in all competitions for which they have qualified, unless they have been granted dispensation by the discipline Rep. This will normally only be given where a medical or veterinary certificate certifying that the rider or horse is unfit to compete, is produced for the competition concerned. - All athletes and horses are required to appear in parades when requested to do so.
- Prize-winners should be mounted when receiving their awards & both horse and rider must be properly dressed & turned out.
- No blankets may be worn in the competition arenas unless permission is given by the show convenors.
- Failure to co-operate and comply with these obligations may result in the forfeiting of all prize-money, rosettes, trophies and/or grading points for that athlete, unless permission is given by the discipline Rep.

Exercising of Horses and Ponies - At no time during the event may horses be exercised in the competition arenas. Only designated, officially supervised warm up arenas may be used.

Responsibility for damage, loss or injury:

The Sponsors, SAEF, SASJ, Maple Ridge and their officials shall in no way be responsible for any damage, loss or injury sustained by owners, competitors and members of the public or any other persons or their property whatsoever.

SASJ – R750 as per SASJ Regulations

Classes will be run at 350 mpm unless conditions necessitate a change 0.70cm, 0.80cm & 0.90cm @ 300 mpm & 1.00m classes will be run at 325 mpm. All classes will be run under SASJ Jumping Rules and those applying to the Junior/young rider South African Championship.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict entries for the jumping classes to a workable maximum giving preference to higher levels and team competitors.

Entry fees will be refunded for any entries NOT accepted.

No rider may ride more than two horses in the 2014 South African Junior/Young Rider Championships of S A.

The same horse may not compete in the 1.35 SA Young Rider Show Jumping Championship and the 1.30 SA Junior/Young Rider Championship.

CODE OF CONDUCT **FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE**

The South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF) expects all those involved in National Equestrian sport to adhere to SAEF's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that the welfare of the pony/horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition ponies/horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farrier and tack, and transportation.
2. Ponies and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.

- Events must not prejudice pony/horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the pony/horse for onward travel after the event.
- Every effort must be made to ensure that ponies receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care,



competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

- SAEF urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

SHOW JUMPING

SECTION 1A – National Schedule

REGULATIONS and NOTES:

- All Show Jumping will be run under FEI Jumping Regulations and SASJ Regulations. FEI Veterinary rules will be applicable with the SASJ MCP Testing and NHA Laboratory. By entering on the SASJ online system riders, guardians and parents accept the regulations and process of SASJ for MCP Testing.
- All Horse and Ponies must have valid passports authorised by the South African Equestrian Federation.
- It is the Athletes/Owners responsibility to ensure that they comply with the control measures of African Horse Sickness and Equine Flu. The batch numbers and dates of the last two vaccinations against Equine Flu and AHS must be stated in the Horses passport – these must comply with the vaccinations on the horses SASJ profile. Should these vaccinations not comply the Athlete will be issued with a fine.
- All Athletes should be aware of the South African Drug Free Sport and WADA regulations and prohibited substances – all these are available on : <http://www.drugfreesport.org.za>
- All Athletes are also to ensure they are aware of the Equine Anti Doping and Medication Control Programme. All information and the current FEI Equine Prohibited Substances list of Banned Substances and Controlled Medications are available on the FEI Clean Sport Website as a PDF document, Database or smart phone app.
- Horse Inspection:** The OC will publish on the Timetable the time for the horse inspection for all ponies and horses in the CN classes.

Horses that tie for a place will each receive the same number of points. **Please note:** Qualifying points will be awarded to each class preceding the Championship – Points will be awarded 10 points for 1st 9 points for 2nd accordingly – The top 24 competitors in classes 1.2.3 will be eligible to compete in the 1.35 Championship The top 24 in classes 5,6,7 Jun/YR riders will be eligible to compete in the 1.30 Championship I

Championship classes will be restricted to the leading 24 competitors in the qualifying classes based on the above points system. Riders may not ride more than two horses/ponies per championship.

SECTION 060 REGULATIONS S A CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

119 NATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS

1 Eligibility of Athletes

Athletes must have been normally resident within the Republic for a period of twelve consecutive months or more, immediately preceding the closing date for entries, and must have their principal place of residence in the Province which they are representing, as at the closing date of entries.

2 Intention To Compete

1 PEXCOs wishing to enter in National Team Championships shall notify the CEO and the OC of the event in writing of their intention to participate, before the closing date for entries.

2 Each PEXCO may only enter one team

3 Nominations

1 PEXCOs shall submit details of their team, in writing, to the CEO and to the OC of the event , not later than seven clear days before the first competition day of the event.

2 Horses and Athletes nominated in terms of this regulation must already have been entered for at least one individual class at the event before the closing date for entries.

3 The nominations shall state the first and last names of the athletes and the names of the horses together with the name of the Chef d'Equipe. Nominations will not be accepted unless the name of the Chef d'Equipe is included. The Chef d'Equipe shall ipso facto be the Team Captain.

4 The total number of nominations allowed is as follows:

Athletes	5
Horses	6

5 Team nominations for National Team Championships shall be certified by the PEXCO of the Province concerned as being correct and in accordance with the rules.

4 Final Selection

1 The final selection of the Team shall be submitted by the Chef d'Equipe to the OC of the event and to the Technical Delegate by not later than 17h00, or such other time as the Technical Delegate may determine, on the day immediately prior to the Competition.

2 The Technical Delegate shall then, in the presence of the Chefs d'Equipe and the OC draw the order of starting of teams.

3 The selected team shall be chosen from those Athletes and horses nominated in terms of 7.11.2 hereof.

4 The following details shall be submitted together with the Final Selection:

Selected Horse and Athlete combination (4)
Reserve Athlete (1)
Reserve Horses (2)
Order of riding of horses

5 Should a team at the time of selection only be able to produce three Horse and Athlete combinations, then that team shall compete with only three Horse and Athlete combinations.

- 6 Reserves
- The Athlete and Horses nominated in terms of 7.11.2 above, but not included in the final selection are ipso facto the reserves
- 5 Team Substitutions**
- 1 Before Final Selection
- No substitution of Horses or Athletes for those nominated in terms of 11.11.2 above is permitted within the seven days prior to the first competition day of the event. It is the duty of PEXCOs to ensure that they nominate sufficient horses and athletes so that should any nominee be unable to compete for any reason, they will still be able to field a team.
- 2 After Final Selection
- 1 If any athletes or horses included in the final selection are unable to compete by reason of injury, illness or death of an athlete or horse occurring after the final selections, and as certified by a medical or veterinary certificate, the Chef d'Equipe may substitute an athlete, a horse or horse and athlete combination, only from the reserves.
- 2 The Chef d'Equipe may change the Athlete on any of the horses selected for another Athlete provided both Athletes were included in the final selection (excluding reserves). In this case no medical certificate is required.
- 3 Notice of this substitution shall be given in writing to the Technical Delegate and to the OC before the commencement of the first round of the championship concerned and shall be accompanied by the relevant medical or veterinary certificate, if required.
- 4 Under no circumstances may the order of riding of the horses within their teams be changed.
- 6 Combined Teams**
- Should any two or more PEXCOs be unable to compete in a National Team Championship due to the lack of Athletes/horses of the required standard, then they may combine to send one team. This team shall in all respects be deemed to be a team entered by a PEXCO.
- 7 FEI Art 273 – 2 Round Competition Rule**
- This competition shall be run over two rounds of a Championship course of national standard and in accordance with FEI Art 273.3.2. Speed 350mpm.
