GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show will be run under the rules of SAEF, SASA, DSA, SASJ, EQSA & the Border Equestrian Club and all relevant rules and regulations apply.
2. The SAEF, SASA, DSA, EQSA & SASJ levies have been included in the entry fee and are detailed in the schedule.
3. Results for graded classes will count for grading points, subject to the approval of the relevant SAEF Official.
4. All riders to wear protective headgear on the show grounds. Children & Juniors to wear correct restraining harness on hat as stated in rule 12.2.2.
5. SAEF, SASA, DSA, EQSA, SASJ, BEC, ELAAIS and Show Organisers will not accept responsibility for any loss of property, damage or injury sustained by owners, competitors and members of the public or any other person or their property at Border Equestrian Club for the duration of the Show.
6. **The owner of any dog not on a leash will be fined.**
7. No late entries or entries without proof of payment will be accepted. Entries without valid flu and AHS details won't be accepted.
8. It is the competitor's responsibility to check whether their entries have been received.
9. This is a multi-discipline show and we will make all efforts to make sure classes don't clash, but if it is impossible competitors will have to choose which classes, they will be competing in.
10. **No refund will be given after closing date of entries if a competitor scratches for whatever reason. If you have entered this show, and scratch your entry after closing date, you will still be liable to pay your fees.**
11. By entering a stallion at the BEC, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol: Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion. It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person. The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider. Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the BEC premises. All stallions must wear a yellow tag on their bridles at all times.
12. For each RIDER riding more than 3 horses, every 4th horse is exempt from the horse levy. This is applicable to "Horses per RIDER", not "Horses per Stable yard or per Owner" if ridden by different riders. If one of the horses is ridden by a Riders' child and the child is under 18 years old, this will count as a horse for the main rider and therefore towards the free horse fee. Please contact the BEC if you feel that you should qualify for this free horse discount.
13. Junior and Adult classes may be combined if entries are insufficient to hold the classes individually. In showing & dressage classes, separate prizes will be awarded for Juniors and Adults.
14. The program appearing in this schedule is STRICTLY PROVISIONAL and may change once all entries are received. Competitors are urged not to enter classes based purely on provisional program times.
15. Prize money awarded will only be done so for GRADED classes

Showing will be run under the auspices of the SAEF & Showing Association of South Africa.
SASA Show Rules edition 26 effective 1st January 2026 will apply.

1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.
2. All Riders and Horses must be registered with a Club, SAEF and SASA. For Membership see the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za or from admin@showingsa.co.za.
3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in a maximum of 4 Ridden classes per day. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at www.showingsa.co.za or contact admin@showingsa.co.za for more information. EDTS competitors will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 26 effective 1st January 2026
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website www.showingsa.co.za
13. Newcomers are open to riders who have never competed in graded classes in any age group. No cross entry with Graded Classes.
14. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
15. The horse and rider combination will compete as a member of the province where the rider is resident.

RULES

No cross entries of Horse/Ponies are allowed between Open & Novice classes (i.e. you may not enter Open Graded Show Riding and Novice Graded Show Hunter). Cross entries between Showing and each Working Class are allowed (i.e. Open Graded Showing and Novice Graded Working Classes). Cross entries are allowed between Novice Graded Working Classes and Open Graded Working Classes (i.e. Novice Graded Working Riding and Open Graded Working Hunter and vice versa).

Criteria for Training / Recreational showing Classes ARE NOT allowed to cross entry with any Graded Classes.

SASA Riding classes are open to Graded and non-graded riders.
