Dress:	School Blazers and school ties may be worn in classes, if riders do not have the correct discipline attire For the team show jumping, riders may use shirts in their school colours without jackets if they wish.

Notes: This Interschools competition is in no way linked or affiliated to SANESA Schools.

- The organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine, limit or divide classes if necessary and if number of entries do not warrant the running of the class, so long as this does not affect team riders. In addition, the organizers reserve the right to change arenas should conditions or entries warrant the change.
- N.B: SUBSTITUTIONS OF HORSE OR RIDER HAVE TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO START OF THE CLASS.
- Should the Substitution be Horse AND rider, Substitution Form has to be signed by both old and new competitor and Substitution Form received by show holder 24 hours prior to the start of the show.
- All horses/ponies and riders must be registered with SAEF.
- Entries out of order by closing date will be forfeit.
- Should the show need to be postponed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, all entries will be carried forward to a new date. Should the show be cancelled for circumstances beyond the organizer's control, entries will be refunded less 20% admin fee

INDIVIDUALS RIDING FOR SCHOOL TEAMS: Competitors participating in the School Teams for all disciplines must enter classes & pay individually – there are individual prizes as well as the team awards.

PONY RIDERS: Pony riders wishing to compete on their ponies for their High School may do so as long as the Rider is a registered learner in their High School i.e. Grade 8 and above.

No Adult may ride any Junior/Pony Rider horse/pony entered in the show from one hour prior to the first class of the show until the end of the team jumping under penalty of elimination. (except in the case of a school pupil who is registered as an adult competitor riding their own horse)

GENERAL RULES FOR SCHOOL TEAMS:

1. ALL Riders & Horses nominated to ride in a School Show Jumping Team MUST compete in at least one of the Individual show jumping classes.
2. ALL Riders representing their school in any school team must be pupils of the High School Section of their School. This is not a show for Junior School Pupils. i.e. only Pupils registered in Grade 8 or above may be part of the school's teams..
3. All teams are to be nominated & entered on this special Team Entry Form, signed and stamped by the Principal or person designated by the School. Competitors participating in School Teams must also enter the Individual events.
4. A Team shall consist of 4 riders/4 horses provided they are all pupils of the same High School. Or a minimum of 3 riders/3 horses from the same school. The best 3 scores will count towards the Team Results in all disciplines
5. Only one horse per rider per team (school) per discipline will be allowed. Each rider may only represent their school once in each discipline (ie you may not ride two horses in one or two teams)
6. Schools may combine, provided they do not have 4 riders of a suitable level at the discipline in any one School. A combined School Team may consist of 3 or 4 riders.
All Dressage & Equitation Teams must have their final team confirmation by 07h45 on Friday 20th March Box - failing which the original School Entry will be accepted to be correct.
7. A School entering two or more teams please note: If a horse/rider in a Team is unable to compete, the 4th rider/horse from either of the Teams may change Teams. The change of rider/horse must be nominated 1 hour prior to the start of the event.
8. Each rider may only represent their school once in each discipline – they cannot ride one horse in the A team, and another in the B team.

PROPOSED SCHEDULE OF CLASSES AND EVENTS

FRIDAY 20th March

EQUITATION - Classe E1 – E9 Individual equitation classes from intro to open level.

(Only one test per rider will be ridden. The individual score from each competition- intro, welcome, novice, intermediate & open, **parts 1 & 2**, will count toward the team placing. An additional 3 points for Open, 2 points for Intermediate and 1 point for novice per rider will be added to the final score of part 1 & part 2 for the Team Riders. Top 3 rider's scores will count.

Riders must fill in the grade they enter in on school team entry form as well)

DRESSAGE Classes D1 – D21 individual ungraded dressage classes from prelim to medium

Each grade has a warm up class (not compulsory) and the team class. If you are riding for a team, you must enter this class as an individual as well. All classes have individual prizes.

Team scoring : an additional 3 points for Medium, 2 points for Elementary and 1 point for novice per rider will be added to the final score of the Team Riders. Top 3 rider's scores will count.

Riders must fill in the grade they enter in on school team entry form as well)

Team equitation & dressage prize giving will be held on Sunday morning after the Team Turn out Parade

SUNDAY 22ND MARCH

TEAM TURN OUT PARADE

This is a very prestigious event where each school sends one team (consisting of any 4 rider/horse combinations who have taken part in any of the team events at the show) into a “turnout” competition. If a school only has 3 riders in total across all disciplines, their team may consist of 3 riders. The teams are judged by a panel of experts who examine the turnout of the riders and horses, condition of the horses and their saddlery. The winning school is presented with the A.C.Smith Rose Bowl – a beautiful trophy that has been presented for decades.

This year for the first time, we are going to shorten the format (which has long been an issue), and it will run as follows : each school will enter a team of 4 riders (or 3 riders if they do not have 4 competing in team events). They will all do a brief walk around to be judged on their general team impression, and then the judges will draw two numbers per team out of a hat, and those 2 horses and riders will be thoroughly judged. This will cut the parade time by almost half, which I'm sure will be greatly appreciated.

SHOW JUMPING

After the Team parade and prize givings for Equitation, Dressage, and the Team Turnout, the Team Show Jumping will commence. This class is held over a duplicate course of jumps – a lower course (85/90cm) and higher course (1.10m) – riders who are currently competing at 1m or lower jump the 85/90cm jumps, and those who compete at 1.10m or higher jump the higher course. Each school team can consist of all lower grade entries, all higher grade, or a mixture of both. Riders in the teams have to have competed in at least one of the individual classes at the show to be eligible for the team. The top 3 scores from each team count, & in the event of equality of scores after the first round, 2 horses are nominated per team to do a jump off round against the clock, to ascertain the overall winning team. All riders and horses must be registered with SAEF & SASJ. The team show jumping prize giving will complete our weekend.
