



The Ultimate 4x4 Series Powered by Toyota

1. Introduction

The showjumping element of the Ultimate 4x4 series consists of the following eight classes, which will be hosted by KPC and sponsored by Toyota SA in 2026 at the following events.

EVENT 1: Toyota Easter Festival

- A1.50m Competition
- A1.50m Outdoor Grand Prix

EVENT 2: Toyota World Cup Qualifier (CSIW Midrand)

- A1.50m Riders Grand Prix (Platinum Tour)
- A1.50m World Cup Qualifier

EVENT 3: Toyota South African Adult Showjumping Championship

- A1.50m Competition
- A1.50m South African Individual Championship

EVENT 4: Toyota South African Derby

- A1.50m Competition
- A1.50m South African Derby

2. Definitions

- “Event” —The term “Event” is used to refer to each of the four shows: the Toyota Easter Festival, the Toyota World Cup Qualifier, the Toyota SA Adult Showjumping Championships and the Toyota South African Derby.
- “Series” – The term “Series” is used to refer to the overall competition running across the four Events with their eight classes.
- “Classes” – The term “Class” refers to the eight individual A1.50m classes, as outlined above.

3. Qualification and eligibility of horse and rider

- **Entry and Qualification for SA Titles as per SASJ Regulations.**
- The Series is restricted to all horse and rider combinations that qualify and ride in the four Events in a minimum of six of the Classes outlined above. The winner of the Series must qualify and take part in the South African Derby Class.

4. Order of starting

As per each 1.50m class or competition rules.

5. Rules

- A rider may have as many horses as allowed in the Event/Class Rules. Points are allocated to each horse and rider combination.
- The winning combination must qualify and compete (go through the start) in the A1.50m SA Derby Class.
- The winner of the entire series will be the combination with the highest total number of points from six out of the eight classes mentioned above. If a combination competes in seven classes, they are allowed a dropped score. If a combination competes in eight classes, they are allowed two dropped scores.

- Points are allocated per place as laid out in the table above. The only exception is for the A1.50m SA Derby Class, which has a points rating of 2 times the standard points.
- Combinations that tie are awarded full points for that place e.g. tied 2nd means that the combinations both get 47 points and there will be no points allocated for 3rd place.
- If a combination is leading, but for whatever reason drops out of one of the Events or fails to take part in the 1.50m SA Derby Class then they are out of contention, regardless of their point tally (even if they are the eventual winners on points).
- In the unlikely event of equality in points, the winner will be the combination with the highest placing in the A1.50m SA Derby Class.
- The winner of the Ultimate 4x 4 Series powered by Toyota will be announced at the Toyota SA Derby where they will be presented with the Toyota Hilux.
- In the event of a dispute not covered by the rules or an ambiguity, Toyota SA has the final decision.

6. Toyota Bonus Award

The Toyota SA Derby winner is guaranteed a bonus award to the value of R50 000 over and above the R100 000 first-place prize.
