<p><b>What's the KPC League?</b></p>	<p>The KPC League has been created to build KPC Club spirit: for us all to celebrate our world class facilities; compete in graded classes and enjoy the festivities as the KPC family. KPC merchandise will be on sale and members may ride in their KPC shirts.</p>																																
<p><b>How does it work?</b></p>	<p>There are three legs of the 2026 KPC League:  1<sup>st</sup> Leg is on 31 January/1 February; the 2<sup>nd</sup> Leg is on 18/19 April; 3<sup>rd</sup> Leg 29/30 August and the final is on 5/6 December.  Non-members can compete, but only KPC members will accumulate League points in each class over the three legs.  The rider with the most points will be crowned the 2026 KPC Champion of each grade at the KPC Gala Awards Dinner to be held at the end of the year. There will be wonderful prizes for all the winners. Non-members can join KPC before or at the show to be eligible to earn points.</p>																																
<p><b>How does the individual scoring work?</b></p>	<p>Points are awarded for placings in all classes.  1st place receives 100 points, and subsequent placings receive points as per the table below. All riders from 16<sup>th</sup> place onwards receive 30 points. The KPC Champion in each grade will be the rider who accumulates the most points over the three legs. Should a rider ride more than one horse in a class, only the highest score will be allocated to that rider. The scores of the final leg of the League on 5/6 December 2026 will be weighted and will count 1.5 x the points. <p><b>How does the Team Event work?</b></p>	<p>The Team Events will take place on the Sunday of the KPC League show. The portion of the show is separate to the individual competition with individual KPC League classes running as normal throughout the weekend.  All disciplines are invited to have a Team Event (i.e. Dressage, Equitation, Showing and Showjumping), but a minimum number of teams is required for the competition to be held. Equally, the number of teams is capped at a maximum to ensure the individual classes can all take place.  Some of the Team Event may not be graded as per individual discipline regulations.  Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Adults can all take part in the same team.  Teams pay R1000 excl. VAT to buy into the Team Event. For this buy in they:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Are guaranteed space in the Team Event for their chosen discipline for the three shows.</li> <li>2) Are permitted to wear their Team shirts for the Team Event.</li> <li>3) Will feature on our KPC social media pages, as well as on the HQ Magazine social media pages.</li> </ol> <p><b>Dressage teams</b> must have a minimum of four and a maximum of eight members. There must be one Prelim rider, one Novice rider, one Elementary rider and one rider at Medium level and above. Riders may be from any age group except PR and Children's Prelim which is ridden in a different sized arena. Teams may enter up to two riders per level, but only the highest score will contribute to the team's final ranking points. Each rider will ride one test at their level.  <b>Showjumping teams</b> must have a minimum of four and a maximum of eight members. There must be one 70cm rider, one 80cm rider, one 90cm rider and one 1m rider. Teams may enter up to two riders per level but only the best score will contribute to the team's ranking points.  <b>Showing teams</b> should have five members. Each team should field one Show Hack or Pony, one Show Hunter or Pony, one Show Riding Horse or Pony, one Working Riding Horse or Pony and one Working Hunter or Pony. The lowest scoring combination will be the dropped score for that Team</p>																																

	<p><b>Equitation teams</b> should have four riders. 1. Competitors may only ride one horse in each class, except in the Working Classes, where they may ride up to three horses.

3. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in a maximum of 4 Ridden classes per day. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. 4. Working Hunters will be required to jump a course of approximately 8-12 fences, one of which will be a combination.
5. Should a competitor qualify more than one horse for the championship, he may nominate another rider, who must be a paid-up member of SASA, to show the horse in that championship. However, the competitor must do the individual test required in the Championship.
6. All classes will be run under SASA Rules Edition 26, effective 1st January 2026
7. EVERY COMPETITOR ENTERING THIS SHOW DOES HEREBY INDEMNIFY ANY JUDGE REGISTERED WITH SASA, OFFICIATING AT THIS SHOW, AGAINST ANY CLAIM OF ANY NATURE FROM ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER.
8. Registered SASA Instructors will earn Victor Ludorum points for pupils.
9. Open Horses may be ridden by the Judge
10. Heights of Horses and Ponies must be stated in the SASA passport.
11. The minimum age of horses shown under saddle shall be 3 years.
12. All competitors, owners and sponsors shall be registered with a club in whose area of jurisdiction they have their principal place of residence, SAEF and SASA and shall be re-registered on 1 January each year. 13. Newcomers are open to riders who have never competed in graded classes in any age group. No cross entry with Graded Classes.
14. Horses shall be registered with SAEF and SASA.
