GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. We regret that no horse may enter the show without a horse flu vaccination and AHS, please complete details (date & batch number) on entry form.
- 2. NO refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratchings after closing date of entries.
- 3. Times will be up on the notice board 24 hours prior to the commencement of a show, and the final programme will be e mailed to all members of the Club. Non-Members may send the club secretary an e-mail requesting the programme and it will be forwarded. NO times will be given over the phone.
- 4. Please Note: the Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, vary, divide or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received. .
- 5. Insofar as possible, the program and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to. However, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavorable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances and should the show be cancelled for any reason only 50% of entry fees will be refunded. No entries will be refunded if the show is postponed.
- 6. SAEF, the ESA, SASA, AND SASJ or Dolcoed Equestrian Centre or Dolcoed Midlands Riding Club, the organizers and any officials appointed by these shall in no way be held responsible for any damage, loss, injury sustained by owners, competitors, members of the public or any other person or persons or their property at the venue for the duration of show.
- 7. Depending on entries; classes may be combined and/or handicapped and separate prizes will not be awarded. This applies to jumping classes.
- 8. Any entry fees for show jumping classes include the following levies: Ungraded (R20 Helpers levy, R10 SJSA Levy) All Pony Rider Graded Classes (R20 Helpers levy, R4.50 EDTS Levy, R10 SJSA Levy). Junior and Adult Classes: 80cm (R20 Helpers levy, R10 SJSA Levy), 90cm and 1m ((R20 Helpers levy, R15 SJSA Levy). 1:10m and 1:20m ((R20 Helpers levy, R30 SJSA Levy). All open classes (R20 Helpers levy, R46.50 SJSA Levy).
- 9. By entering a stallion, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
 - i. Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
 - ii. It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
 - iii. The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
 - iv. Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the venue.
 - v. All stallions must wear a yellow tag on their bridles at all times.
- 10. PLEASE NOTE: THE GRADED ARENAS AT THE CLUB ARE CLOSED FROM THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES, THIS EXCLUDES THE WARM-UP ARENAS.
- 11. The show holding body of Dolcoed Midlands Riding Club reserves the right to limit entries, depending on the total number of entries received per class.
- 12. Please note that a horse or pony may not compete in more than 5 classes across all disciplines per day. Please note that the relative discipline rules wrt classes per day will apply in conjunction with the Club rule of no more than 5 classes per horse or pony per day. SA Show Jumping rules no more than 3 rounds per day.
- 13. Absolutely NO DOGS allowed.

Please note that this is part of a multi-discipline show weekend and riders are encouraged to enter the Show Jumping, Eventing and Welsh Pony classes through the weekend keeping in mind the effort for the horse or bring a second ride. SHOWING

NEW ENTRY FEES APPLICABLE FROM 1 SEPTEMBER 2013. R95 per class for all in hand classes, lead rein classes, first pony classes, handy hunter classes, and all SA Riding classes (best trot etc). Entry fees include the following levies: R18.75 (Un-Affiliated SA Riding Classes) and R4.50 EDTS Levy. R35 per entry for all games. A temporary membership for Non SASA members and their horses, may be paid in order to compete in the Showing Classes. The fee for the temporary membership is R30. NOTE-No Grading points are received by temporary members. All classes will be run under SASA Rules- 14th Edition (Revised July 2013). Cross Entries are not allowed between Lead Rein and First Pony Classes. Best in Show presented to the horse\Pony Rider combination with the most points in each section. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st - 4 points 2nd - 3 points 3rd - 2 points 4th - 1 point. Club members points will go towards Victor Ludorums.

HANDY HUNTER This is showing with a difference! Conformation does not play a part and plaiting is not necessary. The competition consists of an obstacle course of half hunter type jumps and half working riding obstacles. The Winner is the FASTEST CLEAR Round! No marks for style and manners. The course will be designed to prevent wild galloping, it will be a controlled, thinking course.

The competitors are allowed 3 tries at every obstacle (no penalties- just time wasted) the only penalties are for knocking down an obstacle.

HANDY HUNTER RULES:

- 1. No marks for Conformation, turnout, style and manners.
- 2. The competitor with the fastest clear round that completes all the obstacles is the winner.
- 3. Competitors enter the arena one at a time and start as the bell goes.
- 4. 5 penalties will be awarded to jumps or obstacles knocked down.
- 5. 3 attempts are allowed at all obstacles and jumps. Failure on the third attempt will result in Elimination.
- 6. Competitors enter the arena one at a time and commence on the bell.
- 7. Any Competitor failing to complete any obstacle cannot be placed over those that do complete all the obstacles
